**ORDER**  
**(Date of hearing 23.02.2018)**

The case was last heard on 19.12.2017 in which the Commission had directed UPPCL to file their final reply in the matter and had also directed UPPCL to make the payment of bills of the generator for the period prior to 1<sup>st</sup> July 2017.

2. The matter was heard again on 23 January 2018. In the hearing the Commission directed UPPCL that the payment up to June 2017 should be made at the rate admissible as per PPA. Further, UPPCL was directed to file their final reply to justify the rate of Rs.5.56 per unit proposed by them to all the generators whose rates are more than Rs.5.56 as per the PPA. And in the meantime the Petitioner was allowed to run the plant for one month, if they so wish, and accept the provisional tariff of Rs.5.56 per unit for this period subject to final decision of the Commission in the matter. The matter was listed for hearing on 23.02.018.

4. In the hearing on 23.02.2018, the petitioner sought adjournment.

5. The Commission granted the adjournment and fixed the next date of hearing on 20.03.2018.
