## PUBLIC NOTICE

M/s Ghatampur Transmission Limited has filed an application for grant of Intra-State transmission license within the state of Uttar Pradesh. The salient features of the application were published by the applicant in daily newspapers "The Pioneer" (English), "Indian Express" (English), "Pioneer" (Hindi), & "Jan-satta" (Hindi) dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2018. The public notice also invited comments of various stakeholders on the application. No comments / objections have been received in response to above notifications within the stipulated time either at the Commission or with the applicant. State Transmission Utility has, however, not submitted its recommendation in the matter in accordance with section 15(4) of Electricity Act, 2003.

The applicant has complied with the provisions of UPERC (General conditions of Transmission License) Regulations, 2005 for grant of Intra state transmission licence. The commission is prima facie of the view that the applicant satisfies conditions for grant of license for proposed intra state transmission system.

Before granting the license, the U.P. Electricity Regulatory Commission (UPERC) proposes to hear various interested stakeholders on the application of the Intra-State Transmission License by M/s Ghatampur Power Transmission Company Ltd., on 28<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 at 11:30 hours, in the office of the Commission at Vidyut Niyamak Bhawan, Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow – 226010.

Interested stakeholders may take this opportunity to present their comments/objections to the Commission and may give a copy of the same in writing. State Transmission Utility is also directed to submit its recommendation in the matter immediately.
