(Date of Public Hearing 9.9.2015)

- 1. UPPCL requested for approval of second extension approved by GoUP.
- 2. Sri A.K.Verma, Chairman, UPRVUP made written submission and stated that the extension may not be allowed in consumer interest as cost of electricity from these projects are not known yet. He further stated that GoUP representative should be present during hearings and only benchmark capital cost may be allowed for the projects.
- 3. Sri R. S. Awasthi submitted that since these projects are cost plus, with such extensions the costs would go upto what extent is not known and so the timelines may be freezed. He further stated that as these projects still do not have coal linkage, the viability is in question.
- 4. Sri S.N.M.Tripathi, LAPL submitted that first unit has been synchronized on 9.6.15 and requested that in view of scheduled CoD in December, 2015, the second extension may be allowed.
- 5. Representatives of the developers requested for early approval of extension.
- 6. The Commission directed parties to submit agreed capital cost as per the regulations within one month. The developers were further directed to submit copies of investment approvals and UPPCL was directed to submit suggestions for capping of fixed and variable charges including the capping on cost of coal if purchased in addition to FSA. Furthermore, UPPCL was also directed to put forward views on making them party in contracts for procurement and execution of these projects.
- 7. Detailed order shall follow subsequent to submissions.
