Order

(Date of Hearing 02.07.2014)

1. The Petitioner has entered into a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with UPPCL on 23rd day of July, 2012 for supply of 8 MW surplus power from its 12 MW non-conventional energy generating plant situated at Sahajanwa, Distt Gorakhpur. The power is generated on Rice Husk and Slop. While approving the PPA vide order dated 11.9.2013, as the dedicated evacuation system was not ready, permission for temporary solid tapping with existing 132 KV Barahauwa-GiDA line was accorded till 31.3.2014. The Generation was shown on 90% rice husk and 10% slop therefore, as per CNCE Regulations, 2009 Scheduled –II (B) (a) and (E) (ii), the tariff was determined which was also applicable till 31.3.2014.
2. The petition has been filed as the dedicated evacuation system is still not ready. During the hearing, the Executive Engineer of UPPTCL stated that due to Right of Way (RoW) problems, the delay has occurred. He added that they would complete the work by March, 2015. The Representative of M/s India Glycols Limited requested for extension of permission for temporary solid tapping till 31.3.2015 and also requested for extension of tariff for FY 2014-15.
3. The Commission decided to allow the extension of permission for temporary solid tapping till 31.3.2015 with the direction to complete the work within extended period. Regarding the tariff, the Commission decided to allow the tariff for FY 2014-15 as determined for FY 2013-14 provisionally. However, the consumption of fuel, for verification of percentage of consumption of rice husk and slop, for all the supplies has to be certified by statutory auditor and verified by the officer of UPPCL. The tariff be taken on weighted average basis according to the table as provided in order dated 11.9.2013.
4. The petition is disposed of.
