**ORDER**

**(Hearing held on 22.7.2014 & 23.03.2015)**

The petitioner has filed petition no. 924/2013 on 12.12.2013 in the matter of Application for grant of Distribution License in the area of Wave Hi-Tech City Ghaziabad in the State of Uttar Pradesh in terms of the provisions laid under Section 14 read with Section 15 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and in accordance with the requirements of Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (General Conditions of Distribution License) Regulations No. 4361/2004.

Mr. Uppal Chhada Hi-Tech Developers Pvt. Ltd.( UCHDPL) was approved as developer for Hi-Tech township vide G.O. No. 2712-8-1-05 dated 21.5.2005 of Awas and Sahari Niyojan Anubhag – I, Govt of U.P. Lucknow under Govt. of UP policy for development for Hi-Tech township in various towns vide GO No. 6087/9-A-2003-04V/03 dated 22.11.2013.

UCHDPL selected the side along NH-24 in the villages Sadiqpur/Qazipur, Naiphal, Duriyal, Khachera Warsabad, Dujana, Arifpur, Dasna, Mehrauli, Shahapur, Bamhaita, Bayana, Sadat Nagar Iqila, Inayatpur, Talabpur/Hathipur and Girdharpur at Ghaziabad.

Executive Director, U.P. Awas Bandhu designated Ghaziabad Development Authority (GDA) as Competent Authority (CA) for implementation of the project.

The DPR for “Mother City” was approved by the GDA on 5.8.2006. Environment clearance from Ministry of Environment and Forest (MOEF) was issued on 7.10.2009

Clause 19:

“That the second party shall provide basic infrastructure such as road, drainage, water supply, sanitation and electricity etc., free of cost of the village abadis falling within the Hi-Tech Township area. The beneficiaries will pay user charges to the service provider”

7	Electricity Distribution	In case the Second party (UPHDPL) under takes distribution electricity, it shall have to secure licence from Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission for this purpose.

During the hearing on 22.7.2014 the petitioner submitted that they want distribution license for their hitech city develop on NH-24. The Commission inquire whether there is any supply of PVVNL in the area for which they have requested the distribution license. The petitioner replied there is supply of PVVNL in the area. The Commission further inquired whether they want to have parallel license for the aforesaid area or the exclusive license. The petitioner requested some time to file the reply. Commission grants the same.

During the hearing on 23.3.2015 the counsel Shri Dileep Singh, Advocate on behalf of Shri Rajesh Tiwari, Advocate submitted that the case has been handed over to them only few days back so they are unable to file the reply. The Commission grants the same and directs the petitioner to file the reply as directed in the hearing dated 22.7.2014.
