### ORDER

(Date of hearing 03.04.2018)

- U.P. Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. (UPPTCL) has filed a letter dt. 02.04.2018 stating that they are taking some clarifications from Greater Noida Authority in order to file the required affidavit before this Commission and they have prayed for 15 days time for filing the affidavit.
- The Advocate General, U.P. appeared on behalf of UPPTCL. He has stated that he will ensure filing of affidavit in next 15 days time and will not seek any further extension. The representative of NPCL strongly objected and pleaded that they are suffering due to non-availability of connectivity of Garbara Substation and are not getting required bays in RC Green Substation due to the present dispute. They wanted the case to be fixed early and also time to file a rejoinder on the counter affidavit filed by UPPTCL. After hearing both the parties the Commission fixed the next date of hearing on 17.04.2018 at 3:00 PM and directed UPPTCL to file their counter affidavit before 17<sup>th</sup> Apr, 2018 with a copy to NPCL. NPCL can submit their arguments on the next date of hearing.
