### ORDER

## (DATE OF HEARING: 12.06.2025)

- 1. The Petitioner, U.P. Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Limited (UPRVUNL), has filed this Petition seeking true-up of tariff for its Parichha (110 MW) Thermal Power Station for the control period FY 2019-20 to FY 2023-24 under UPERC (Terms and Conditions of Generation Tariff) Regulations, 2019.
- 2. The Petitioner has prayed the following:
  - a) To accept this Petition for true-up of additional capitalization and associated tariff components for the financial year 2019-20.
  - b) To allow recovery of the additional claim generating out of the true up from the beneficiaries in line with the provision of the Regulations or in any manner that the Commission deems appropriate.
  - c) To permit recovery of expenses understated/ not considered in this Petition subsequent to the submission of this petition.
  - d) To condone any inadvertent omissions / errors / short comings and permit the applicant to add /change /modify / alter this Petition and make further submissions as may be required at later stages.
  - e) To pass such orders as the Commission may deem fit and proper and necessary in the facts and circumstances of the case, to grant relief to the Petitioner.
