

Corrigendum to Rate Schedule for the FY 04-05

Rate Schedule LMV-1

- (i) Under Applicability, point 'c' appearing as

"For Townships/Cantonments/Residential colonies (mixed load) having minimum Contracted load of 500 kW and receiving supply at single point."

For above provision, contracted load is 450 kW (500 kVA) in place of 500 kW. Accordingly, the amended provision should be read as

"For Townships/Cantonments/Residential colonies (mixed load) having minimum Contracted load above 500 kVA (450 kW) and receiving supply at single point."

- (ii) Under the 'Rate of Charge', point (b) (i) appearing as:

"For Registered Societies, multi-storied residential complexes (including also lifts, water pumps and common lighting within the premises). Only domestic loads above 50 kW and 450 kW."

For above provision, load limit is above 50 kW and up to 450 kW (500 kVA), whereas the term "up to" is left in the existing provision. Accordingly, the amended provision should be read as

"For Registered Societies, multi-storied residential complexes (including also lifts, water pumps and common lighting within the premises). Only domestic loads above 50 kW and up-to 450 kW (500kVA)."

2. Rate Schedule LMV-2

Under 'Rate of Charge' point (b) Minimum Charge appearing as 'Rs. 260/kW' should be amended as '**Rs. 260/kW/month**'.

3. Rate Schedule LMV-6

Under 'Rate of Charge', point (B) the provision

Minimum charge for consumers on rural schedule shall be Rs. 225/month

In the above provision, the rate indicated is on the basis of per BHP per month. The provision should be amended as

Minimum charge for consumers on rural schedule shall be Rs. 225/BHP/month

4. Rate Schedule LMV-7

Under 'Rate of Charge', point (B) appearing as:

(B)"Consumers getting supply as per Rural Schedule Consumer getting supply as per rural schedule shall be eligible for a rebate of 10% on fixed charges and energy charges."

In the above provision, the phraseology (B)"Consumers getting supply as per Rural Schedule stands deleted. The provision should be amended as

"Consumer getting supply as per rural schedule shall be eligible for a rebate of 10% on fixed charges and energy charges."
