Sub: Your letter dated 16.6.06

Dear Sir,

M/s Triveni Engineering & Industries Ltd. vide letter dated 16.6.06, has sought following clarifications:

- (a) Whether final PPA is required to be framed as per Order dated 25.5.06.
- (b) How shall the tariff be determined of the existing plants undergone an expansion.

In this context, I am directed to inform you as follows:

- (i) The Commission passed Order dated 25.5.06, interalia, in Petition No.333/06 approving the PPA dated 7.4.06 signed between M/s Triveni & UPPCL and directed the petitioner to frame final PPAs in accordance with the Annexure-4 to the Regulations within a month with a copy to the Commission for information. Therefore, the final PPA shall be framed as per the direction of the Commission in the said order.
- (ii) Further, it may be noted that Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Supply of Power and Fixation of Tariff for sale of power from Captive Generating Plants, Co-generation, Renewable Sources of Energy and Other Non-Conventional Sources of Energy based Plants to a Distribution Licensee) Regulations, 2005, No.UPERC/Secy/Regulation/06-1288 dated 23.3.06 in Regulation 3 and 30 deals with the tariff as below:
 - (a) *The tariff in respect of a generating station under these Regulations shall be applicable for the whole of the generating station, (Regulation-3)*

(b) The tariff for supply of electricity by the plant to a distribution licensee shall be as per Schedule – II of these Regulations.

Note:

- 1. The tariff for supply of electricity from the plant, having more than one unit commissioned in different years, shall be based on weighted average of the capacities of the units commissioned in different years.*

.....(Regulation-30)

Therefore, the provisions in these Regulations are explicitly clear that the tariff of a generating plant, having units commissioned in different years, shall be the a weighted average of the capacities.
