ORDER

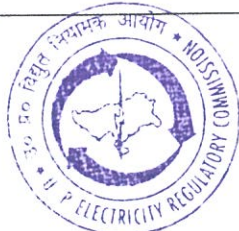
(DATE OF HEARING: 09.04.2024)
