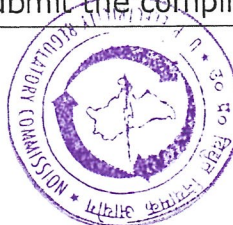

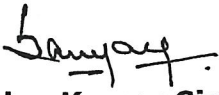
1. The petition has been filed under Regulation 5.4 of U.P. Electricity Regulatory Commission (Promotion of Green Energy through Renewable Purchase Obligation) Regulations, 2010 with the request to permit the Petitioner to carry forward the deficit in meeting the Renewable Purchase Obligations for F.Y. 2021-22 & 2022-23.
2. In its Order dated 02.05.2025, the Commission had allowed the Petitioner to purchase RECs as per the obligations, in the interim, based on the verified data submitted by SLDC, as per UPERC (Promotion of Green Energy through Renewable Purchase Obligation) (First Amendment) Regulations, 2019 within three months. The Petitioner was also directed to submit the compliance on affidavit.

3. During the present hearing, senior counsel for the Petitioner was not present and the junior counsel, who appeared on behalf of the Petitioner, was not adequately acquainted with the facts of the case and was therefore unable to assist the Commission meaningfully. Considering the inconsistent presentation of facts, the Commission deemed it appropriate to grant another opportunity and adjourned the matter to the next date.
