ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 13.08.2026)

1. Sh. Utkarsh Singh, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that, in compliance with the directions of the Commission in the last hearing, he had filed two affidavits containing the project status and related submissions. During the course of the hearing, the Commission observed that the said affidavits were not available on record. In response, Learned Counsel submitted that the affidavit had been filed on 10.08.2026. He further requested for short time to verify the status of filing with the Registry and to remove the discrepancy.



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2. Sh. Divyanshu Bhatt, Learned Counsel for Respondent No. 1, UPPTCL, submitted that he had received copies of the affidavits filed by the Petitioner and did not oppose the request for grant of one week's time. He further sought liberty to file a reply to the affidavits filed by the Petitioner.
3. Sh. Tushar Mathur, Learned Counsel for Respondent Nos- 2 to 7, UPPCL and LTTCs, submitted that he had also received copies of the affidavits filed by the Petitioner and did not oppose the request for extension of time. He further sought liberty to file replies to the affidavits filed by the Petitioner. He further submitted that, as per the affidavits received by him, the Petitioner has now sought extension of SCOD up to 31.03.2027. He contended that such prayers are premature at this stage, as the project has not yet achieved COD, therefore, the issue may be considered only after completion and commissioning of the project.
4. The Commission is of the view that since the project is not yet commissioned therefore, it would first like to determine whether to hear the matter at this stage. Further, the Respondents were also granted liberty to file their replies to the affidavits filed by the Petitioner before the next date of hearing.
5. Accordingly, the matter is next listed for hearing on 03.09.2026
