ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 20.08.2026)

1. The present Petition has been filed by M/s Ayesha Steel Pvt. Ltd. seeking removal of difficulties and clarification under Clause 9.5(i) of the U.P. Electricity Supply Code,





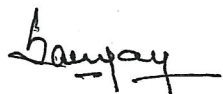
2005 in respect of the provisions governing reduction of contracted load. The Petitioner has submitted that the difficulty has arisen in the interpretation and implementation of Clause 4.41 and Annexure 4.10 of the Supply Code, 2005, in respect to the number and period of electricity bills required to be submitted along with the application for reduction of load.

2. During the previous hearing on 20.01.2026, the learned Counsel for the Petitioner had submitted that, subsequent to the filing of the Petition, certain developments had taken place at their end and therefore he sought time to bring them on record by way of a supplementary affidavit, which was allowed by the Commission. However, no submission has been made by the Petitioner.
3. During the present hearing, Shri Arif Husain appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that since arguing counsel is out of station some more time may be allowed for filing the supplementary affidavit. The Commission observed that even though more than six months have passed since the Commission's previous order dated 06.02.2026, the Petitioner has not bothered to make any submissions.
4. The Commission allows one last opportunity to the Petitioner for making its submission within one week.
5. The matter is scheduled for hearing on 27.08.2026.
