ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 27.08.2026)

1. The present Petition has been filed by M/s Ayesha Steel Pvt. Ltd. seeking removal of difficulties and clarification under Clause 9.5(i) of the U.P. Electricity Supply Code,





2005 in respect of the provisions governing reduction of contracted load. The Petitioner has submitted that the difficulty has arisen in the interpretation and implementation of Clause 4.41 and Annexure 4.10 of the Supply Code, 2005, with respect to the number and period of electricity bills required to be submitted along with the application for reduction of load.

2. The Petitioner has further submitted that there exists an inconsistency between the provisions of the Supply Code, 2005 and that of Cost Data Book 2019 with respect to the requirement of minimum load for supply on 33 kV, particularly in cases where an existing consumer seeks reduction in contracted load.

3. The Petitioner has made the following prayers in the Petition:

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- A. Clarify the provision of clause 4.41 (a) (ii) of Supply Code 2005 that how much electricity bill should be enclosed with the load reduction application whether it is prior to intimation date or past intimation date.
- B. Clarify the Annexure 4.10 that whether three electricity bills are required to be added along with the application for load prior to intimate date or past intimation date.
- C. Clarify/remove the condition of provision in consistency of provision of clause 4.41 of Supply Code 2005 as well as Cost Data Book 2019
- D. page 14 para 22 condition of 33 kVA line is necessary for reduction of contracted load for industry which are operating prior to 5 years before constitution of Data Book 2019."

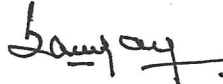
4. During the very first hearing on 20.01.2026, learned Counsel for the Petitioner submitted that subsequent to the filing of the Petition, certain developments had taken place at their end, which were required to be brought on record by way of a supplementary affidavit. Petitioner's Counsel prayed before the Commission seeking time to file supplementary affidavit and requested that the matter be taken up for hearing thereafter. The Commission allowed the Petitioner to file supplementary affidavit and directed to issue fresh notice after supplementary affidavit was filed.





5. The Petitioner did not file any supplementary affidavit for more than six months and therefore notice dated 21.07.2026 was issued and the matter was listed for hearing on 20.08.2026.
6. During the hearing on 20.08.2026, Shri Arif Husain appeared on behalf of the Petitioner and submitted that arguing counsel was out of station thus, sought more time may for filing the supplementary affidavit. The Commission, while observing, that even after a period of more than six months since the Commission's Order dated 06.02.2026, the Petitioner has not bothered to make any submission, allowed one last opportunity to the Petitioner for making its submissions.
7. During the hearing on 27.08.2026 no one appeared for the petitioner. Shri Yashpal Singh, Sub Divisional Officer appearing on behalf of PVVNL submitted before the Commission that the contracted load of the Petitioner has already been reduced as per the Petitioner's request.
8. In view of the above circumstances, the Petition is hereby dismissed.
