ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 06.08.2026)

1. Sh. M.G. Ramachandran, Learned Senior Advocate, appeared on behalf of the Petitioner and sought permission of the Commission to commence his submissions in the matter.
2. Mr. Md. Altaf Mansoor, Learned Counsel, appeared on behalf of Respondent No. 6, UPPTCL.
3. Sh. Deeptanshu Chandak, Learned Brief Holder / Counsel, appeared on behalf of Respondent No. 1-5 LTCCs and Respondent No. 7, UPPCL and submitted that the Learned Counsel, Ms. Priyadarshini, arguing the matter, could not appear on the day before the Commission, therefore a subsequent date be fixed for arguments on behalf of the UPPCL and LTCCs.
4. During the course of the hearing, the Commission observed that the instant matter involves multiple issues requiring detailed consideration.
