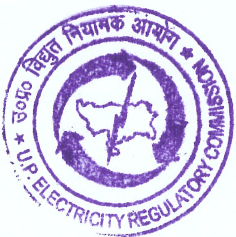

ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 14.07.2026)

1. Sh. Sourav Roy, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner, submitted that the present Petition involves two issues, namely: (i) determination of liability for payment of transmission charges for the period from 24.09.2024 to 11.12.2024 and whether such liability is to be borne by NUPPL or UPPCL; and (ii) the claim relating to Late Payment Surcharge (LPS) and allied issues. He advanced detailed submissions on the first issue relating to liability for payment of transmission charges. However, considering the nature and extent of submissions required on the second issue pertaining to





LPS and connected matters, learned Counsel for the Petitioner requested that the same be taken up on the next date of hearing.

2. Owing to paucity of time, Sh. Abhishek Kumar, learned Counsel appearing on behalf of UPPCL, could not advance his submissions. Upon the request of the learned counsel appearing for the parties, the Commission directed that the matter be listed on a short date for continuation of the hearing.
3. Accordingly, the matter is listed for further hearing on 30.07.2026.
