1. Sh. Aryan Sarawgi, Counsel for the Petitioner, appeared before the Commission and marked his appearance.

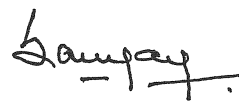




2. Sh. Divyanshu Bhatt, Counsel for the Respondent No.1 (UPPTCL) and Ms. Anannya Sinha, Counsel for the Respondent No.2-7 (UPPCL and State Discoms) appeared before the Commission and sought fifteen (15) days' time to file their replies to the Petition & the IAs.
3. The Commission after hearing the Counsel for the Respondents directs the Respondents to file their replies to the Petition & the IAs within fifteen (15) days from the date of hearing and thereafter Petitioner to file its rejoinder, if any, within four (04) weeks.

However, the Commission, at the outset is of the prima facie view that since the project is not yet commissioned and relief on account of force majeure/change in law could be considered once the project achieves commissioning/COD hence the Commission would decide about appropriateness of hearing the matter at this stage in its next hearing.
4. Accordingly, the matter is next listed for hearing on 22.09.2026.
