ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 09.07.2026)

1. Sh. Abhishek Kumar, Counsel for the Review Petitioner, submitted that Respondent No. 2, Power Finance Corporation Consulting Limited (PFCCL), had filed its reply and that an unofficial copy of the same was received by him on 08.07.2026. In view thereof, he sought permission to file a rejoinder to the said reply.
2. Sh. Divyanshu Bhatt, Counsel for Respondent No. 3 (UPPTCL), submitted that a copy of PFCCL's reply had been duly received by him.
3. Upon a query from the Commission as to whether the Review Petitioner had filed rejoinders to the replies filed by the other Respondents, Counsel for the Review Petitioner submitted that replies of the other Respondents were already on record and that pleadings on their part stood completed. However, since PFCCL's reply





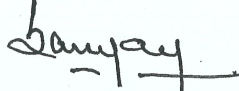
was received only on 08.07.2026, and as the reply contained certain averments requiring a specific response, it was necessary for the Review Petitioner to file a rejoinder.

He further submitted that, in the absence of any representation by PFCCL, it was important that the Review Petitioner be afforded an opportunity to place its response on record, so that no issue remains unanswered at a later stage of the proceedings. Accordingly, he sought two (02) weeks' time to file a rejoinder to the replies of all the Respondents, including PFCCL.

He also submitted that a party filing a reply should participate in the proceedings and present its case before the Commission. He therefore requested that PFCCL be directed to remain present and make submissions during the next hearing.

4. The Commission, after hearing the parties, directs the Review Petitioner to file its rejoinder(s) to the replies filed by the Respondents within two (02) weeks'. The Commission further directs Respondent No. 2 (PFCCL) to remain physically present through its authorised representative during the next date of hearing.
5. The matter is next listed for hearing on 11.08.2026
