(DATE OF HEARING: 09.07.2026)

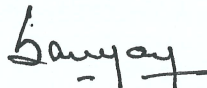
1. Sh. Tushar Mathur, Counsel for the Review Petitioner, submitted that Respondent No. 1 (MSTPL) has filed its reply and that the reply of Respondent No. 8 (UPPTCL) was received only on 07.07.2026. He accordingly sought time to file rejoinders to the replies filed by the Respondents.
