ORDER

1. M/s South East U.P. Power Transmission Company Limited has filed a Petition under section 18(1) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 4.20 of the UPERC (General Conditions of Transmission License) Regulations, 2005 for amendment of Transmission License no. 1 of 2013 granted by UPERC to the Petitioner under section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The petitioner is directed to publish a notice under section 18(2) of the Electricity Act, 2003, with particulars of the application in two daily newspapers (two English and two Hindi) with the following words super-scribed in bold at the top of notice.

In the matter of application by South East U.P. Power Transmission Company for amendment of Transmission License No. 1 of 2013 granted by UPERC

2. In accordance with section 18(2)(d) of the Electricity Act, 2003, comments /suggestions or objections shall be invited from the public through this notice within a period of 30 days from the date of publication of notice. In the notice published in the newspapers, it shall be indicated that suggestions and objections, if any, may be filed before the Secretary, UP Electricity Regulatory Commission, Vidyut Niyamak Bhawan, Vibhuti Khand, Gomti Nagar, Lucknow-226010.
3. In pursuance to section 18(2)(b) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and section 4.2.1(ii) of UPERC (General Conditions of Transmission License) Regulations, 2005, the Petitioner is directed to submit a "No Objection" from the concerned authority of the Central Government if the proposed alterations or modifications in their system is likely to affect any cantonment, aerodrome, fortress, arsenal, dockyard or camp/building/place in the occupation of Government for defence purposes. Further, in case the alterations or modifications in their system of the Petitioner is affecting or is likely to affect any local authority, any central or state authority/body no objection from such authorities/bodies shall also be submitted.





4. The Petitioner is also directed to immediately forward a copy of its application along with all relevant information to the State Transmission Utility, which shall send its recommendations to the Commission within 30 days of receipt of the application. A copy of the report submitted by the STU to the Commission shall also be endorsed to the Petitioner.
5. The Petitioner shall file its comments, duly supported by an affidavit, on the recommendations made by the STU and the suggestions and objections received, if any, in response to the notice published by him, within 15 days of receipt of recommendation of the STU and responses to the notice published in the newspapers respectively, with an advance copy to the STU or the person who has filed the comments / suggestions, as the case may be.
6. Further, the Petitioner shall post the complete application along with annexure and enclosures on its website. The application shall be kept on the website till such time the amendment of license is approved, or the application is rejected by the Commission. The notice to be published in the newspaper should clearly indicate the website address where the complete application is available for the purposes of inspection by anyone. The notice should also mention that the application is available at the Petitioner's head office.
7. The Petitioner shall, within 2 weeks from the date of publication of notice submit to the Commission on affidavit the names and dates of the newspapers in which the notice has been published and shall also file relevant copies of the newspapers.
