

PRESS NOTE OF TARIFF ORDER FOR NIDP FOR FY 2026-27

Dated: 02.07.2026

- **UPERC declares Electricity Tariff Rates for NIDP for FY 2026-27 in accordance with UPERC (Multi Year Tariff for Distribution) Regulations, 2025**
- **First Tariff Order for Data Center in State which is the Parallel Licensee in Greater Noida.**
- **The Tariff categories include LMV-9 (Temporary Supply), LMV-11 (Electric Vehicle Charging), HV-1 (Bulk Load) and HV-2 (Large & Heavy Industry)**
- **Green Energy additional Tariff also remains unchanged; Rs 0.34 per unit for HV category consumers and Rs. 0.17 per unit for LV category consumers which is same as last year.**
- **To promote EV charging infrastructure, Single part Tariff under LMV-11 made applicable to Battery Swapping Stations and Battery as a Service providers**
- **TOD Tariff provided for LMV-11- Tariff during Solar Hours (9AM-4PM) to be 20% lower to promote battery charging during daytime and promote consumption of RE power**

The Tariff Order of NIDP comprising of True-up of FY 2024-25, Annual Performance Review (APR) of FY 2025-26 and Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) of FY 2026-27 has been finalized by the UPERC after taking into consideration the objections, comments & suggestions of the stakeholders, public and the State Advisory Committee. Important features of the Tariff Order are as below:

True up for FY 2024-25

Keeping in view the MYT Regulations, 2019, the Commission in the True up for NIDP has approved the following:

ARR for FY 2026-27

Keeping in view the MYT Regulations, 2025, the Commission in the ARR for FY 2026-27 for NIDP has approved the following:

Other Salient features of Tariff Order for FY 2026-27:

1. Average Cost of Supply projected for FY 2026-27 is Rs. 6.92 /KWh whereas Average Billing Revenue is projected to be Rs. 7.41 /KWh. The surplus generated contributes towards recovery of opening gap for FY 2026-27.
2. Recognising the emerging business models of EV Public Charging Infrastructure, Commission has included Battery as a Service (BaaS) and Battery Swapping Stations as an eligible category for availing Single Part Tariff under LMV-11 category. Also to incentivise the use of charging infrastructure during daytime when the cheaper solar power can be consumed, Commission has introduced TOD Tariff structure for LMV-11 by providing a rebate of 20% during solar hours (from 9AM-4PM). The Commission expects that this rebate will be passed on to ultimate consumers by EV charging infra service providers.

The Tariff Order shall be in force after seven days from the date of publication by the licensee in at least two Hindi and two English Daily newspapers.
