ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 03.09.2026)

1. The Commission, vide its earlier Order dated 29.07.2026, had granted two weeks' time to UPNEDA to file its reply and three weeks' time to the Petitioner(s) to file its rejoinder. On 14.08.2026, UPNEDA filed its reply while Petitioner filed its rejoinder to the UPPCL's reply on 03.09.2026.
2. During the hearing, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner(s) submitted that rejoinder to UPPCL's reply had been filed on the day of hearing itself and requested the Commission for two more days to file its rejoinder to UPNEDA's reply. The Commission expressed its displeasure at the failure of the Petitioner(s) to file the rejoinders within the timelines granted. The Commission further observed that the matter had earlier been dismissed on account of absence during hearings and the Petitioner's continuous failure to comply with the Commission's Orders demonstrates a lack of seriousness in pursuing the matter and it adversely affects timely disposal of the case. Learned Counsel for the Petitioner(s) tendered an apology and emphasised that rejoinder would be file within two days.





3. Having heard the parties, the Commission grants two days' time to the Petitioner(s) to file its rejoinder to the UPNEDA's reply and directs to list the matter for next hearing on 17.11.2026.
