**ORDER**

**(Date of Hearing 25.04.2019)**

1. UPPCL, the Petitioner has filed this Petition for approval of PPA dated 17.04.2018 for purchase of 9MW Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) based power from the plant being put up by M/s Accord Hydroair Pvt. Ltd. at Village Pipalheda, Tehsil Daulana, Distt. Hapur.






2. The Petitioner has stated in the Petition that the provisions in para 2, 3 & 4 under New Model PPA have been found superfluous in respect to this project and have been replaced with the relevant clauses. For this power purchase both the parties have agreed that the tariff for first year of commissioning i.e FY 2019-20 shall be either Rs.7.19 per unit or tariff determined by the Commission in the new regulations for the commissioning year 2019-20, whichever is lower and thereafter the tariff shall be in line with the tariff determined by the Commission from time to time. They have also mentioned that first year tariff shall be applicable in the year in which plant is actually commissioned and in the event of delay in commissioning due to power evacuation system on either end or due to any reason not attributable to UPPCL it shall not be liable to pay any increased tariff or deemed energy to the generating company. The power shall be transmitted to 132kV/33kV grid substation located at Dashna owned by UPPTCL through a 33kV transmission line.
3. They have further mentioned that the construction of evacuation system for connecting the plant with the grid substation shall be the responsibility of generating company which shall construct transmission line under supervision of UPPTCL/DISCOM and Bay at substation shall be constructed by UPPTCL for which the supervision charges and Bay construction charges will be deposited by the Generating Company to UPPTCL/DISCOM as per the deposit works rules.
4. The transmission line constructed for the evacuation of power shall be maintained by the contractor who can opt for the maintenance of line by DISCOM/UPPTCL on the terms mutually agreed with UPPTCL/DISCOM.
5. This matter was heard on 25.04.2019. The representative of UPPCL appeared and requested the Commission to approve the Power Purchase Agreement submitted with the Petition. The Commission in its CRE







Regulations 2014 has allowed setting up of MSW based power plants and has allowed the tariff of Rs.7.50 per unit for the plants commissioned in 2018-19. Since the proposed tariff is less than the tariff approved by the Commission for 2018-19 the Commission approves the PPA signed between both the parties. The tariff for the future years shall be determined in the new CRE Regulations for control period 2019-2024.

6. The petition no.1424 of 2019 stands disposed of accordingly.
