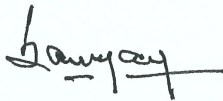


ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 09.07.2026)

1. The Commission, vide its earlier Order dated 19.05.2026, had directed UPPCL to submit revised bidding document after carefully re-examining and incorporating all necessary changes. Further, since there had been several amendments in the matter, UPPCL was directed to file afresh deviation statement with proper justification.
2. During the hearing, Sh. Savyasachi Saumitra, Counsel for UPPCL, requested the Commission to grant additional one week's time to file the requisite documents in compliance to the Commission's Order dated 19.05.2025.
3. The Commission observes that UPPCL itself argues the urgency of procuring peak power on a medium term at one hand while on the other hand, UPPCL fails to comply with its own requested timeline for furnishing the requisite documents. Sh. Savyasachi apologised for the delay and stated that requisite document was under finalisation, which would be placed on record within a week time.
4. The Commission allows the request of UPPCL and adjourns the hearing.
5. List the matter for next hearing on 21.07.2026.
