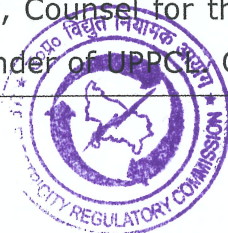

ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 02.06.2026)

1.
