ADMITTANCE ORDER

(DATE OF ORDER: 06.07.2026)

1. According to Section 64 of the Electricity Act, 2003, a Generating Company is required to make an application to the State Electricity Regulatory Commission (SERC) for determination of Tariff, in accordance with the procedure specified by the Commission's applicable Regulations.
2. Dhariwal Infrastructure Ltd. (DIL/Petitioner) filed a Petition (bearing number 2263 of 2025) for approval of Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) and determination of MYT tariff for supply of 187 MW Gross Contracted Capacity for the Period FY 2024-29 from Unit 2 of 2 x 300 MW Coal based thermal generating station of DIL located at Tadali, Chandrapur in the State of Maharashtra to Noida Power Company Limited, in terms of Power Purchase Agreement dated 26.09.2014 along with Addendum dated 04.09.2019 and the Uttar Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Generation Tariff) Regulations, 2024.
3. During the hearing dated 22.01.2026, the Commission allowed ten days' time to the DIL to file additional affidavit and three weeks thereafter to the Respondent to file its reply and two weeks subsequently to the Petitioner for filing their rejoinder. DIL filed its additional affidavit on 12.03.2026. Subsequently, NPCL filed its reply on 02.04.2026 and DIL filed its Rejoinder on 11.05.2026.
4. During the hearing on 07.04.2026, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit revised tariff forms in accordance with the Commission's Order dated 20.03.2026 in Petition No. 2150/2024 in the matter of true up of generation tariff

for the period 2019-24 and allowed four weeks for the same. The Commission allowed three weeks to the Respondent for filing its response post submission of revised tariff forms by the petitioner and two weeks subsequently to the petitioner for filing its rejoinder. DIL, vide an additional affidavit on 01.06.2026, filed revised tariff forms.


5. During the hearing on 16.06.2026, counsel for NPCL raised no objection to the revised tariff forms submitted by DIL. The Commission admitted the Petition for further processing.
6. Thus, the Petitioner, in accordance with Regulation 55 of UPERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2019, shall:
 - i. Within three working days of issue of this Admittance Order, publish a Public Notice in one English and one Hindi daily newspaper having wide circulation in the area, outlining the details of the Petition with ARR & its components and invite suggestions and objections within 21 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice(s) from the stakeholders and public at large.
 - ii. The Public Notice, containing details of Petitioner's website link, shall request the stakeholders and public at large to regularly check the website of the Petitioner in respect of these proceedings.
 - iii. Upload clear and legible copies of the following documents on its website:
 - a. Petition.
 - b. Additional affidavit dated 12.03.2026 filed by DIL
 - c. Reply dated 02.04.2026 filed by NPCL
 - d. Rejoinder dated 11.05.2026 filed by DIL
 - e. Additional affidavit dated 01.06.2026 filed by DIL
7. The Petitioner shall submit a copy of the original Newspaper clippings containing Public Notice and the website link of above documents mentioned at iii (a) to (e) posted on its website before the Commission within a week from the date of this order.
