ORDER

(DATE OF HEARING: 13.08.2026)

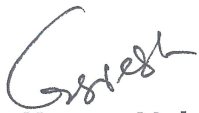
1. The Petitioner, UPPCL has filed instant Petition for approval of 600 MW of Wind Power procurement in terms of the Power Sale Agreement (PSA) dated 30.03.2026 on long term basis through Tariff Based Competitive Bidding (TBCB) process held under the Inter State Transmission System Tranche-XIX Scheme. The prayers of the Petitioner are as follows:
 - a) Approve the procurement of 600MW of Wind Power on long term basis procured by UPPCL from SECI through tariff based competitive bidding process held under the Inter State Transmission System Tranche-XIX Scheme.
 - b) Approve the Power Sale Agreement dated on 30.03.2026 executed between Solar Energy Corporation of India Limited and Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited; and/or
 - c) Pass any further order(s) as this Commission may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.
2. During the hearing, Sh. Divyanshu Bhatt, learned Counsel of UPPCL, submitted that present matter pertains to approval of 600 MW Wind Power procurement under the PSA dated 30.03.2026 through SECI in terms of Section 63 of the Electricity Act, 2003. On specific query of the Commission regarding status of tariff adoption Petition filed before the CERC, Sh. Bhatt responded that the matter was reserved for orders on 29.06.2026 however, the final Order has not yet been issued.
3. The Commission observed that appropriate consideration of the instant Petition shall be undertaken only after the Order of the CERC. The Commission further observed following deficiencies in the matter and asked UPPCL to furnish the following:
 - a) The reason for discrepancy in the mentioned CUF for K.P. Energy Limited and Waaree Forever Energies Private Limited in the PSA dated 30.03.2026 and their corresponding PPAs.
 - b) The discrepancy in the mentioned Wind Power contracted capacity in Paragraph 20 of the Petition than the capacity already approved by the Commission.
 - c) Justification for the present Wind power procurement in terms of CEA's Resource Adequacy Report for UPPCL.

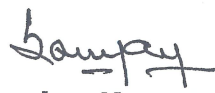




4. Sh. Bhatt submitted that UPPCL shall furnish clarification on the observations by way of an additional affidavit and shall also place on record the final order of the CERC, upon its issuance.
5. Having heard the matter, the Commission admits the matter and allows UPPCL & Respondent to file their respective submission & reply within four weeks' time. The Commission also grants liberty to UPPCL for mentioning the matter, in the event final order is issued by the CERC prior to 06.10.2026.
