ORDER

Chairman, Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL), Madhyanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Lucknow, Purvanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Varanasi, Paschimanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Meerut, Dakshinanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited, Agra has filed a petition (Petition No. 718/2011) on 29th January, 2011 on affidavit before the Commission for approval of the Correction of Electricity Bills and One Time Settlement Scheme (OTS) for surcharge. As per the petition, the scheme would be applicable for Rural Domestic - Light & Fan (LMV-1) and Rural Private Tube well (LMV-5) consumers from 01.02.2011 to 31.03.2011.

Commission's View

Considering their submissions; the Commission allows the proposed scheme with the following modifications:

A. Period of One Time Settlement Scheme (OTS)

(Refer Cl. 1 of UPPCL's Petition No. 718/2011)

This scheme shall be effective from 08.02.2011 to 31.03.2011 for Rural Domestic - Light & Fan (LMV-1) and Rural Private Tube well (LMV-5) consumers.

B. Period of Registration

(Refer Cl. 3 of UPPCL's Petition No. 718/2011)

To avail the benefits of this One Time Settlement Scheme (OTS) the registration will be open from 08.02.2011 to 31.03.2011.

C. Payment & Recovery of dues

(Refer Cl. 5 of UPPCL's Petition No. 718/2011)

Consumers shall be permitted to get themselves registered upto 31.03.2011. Such consumers shall be provided with corrected bill by 07.04.2011 and their payment shall be received on or before 15.04.2011.

Under this scheme all the registered cases shall be deemed to be disposed off on 15.04.2011 and thereafter the recovery of dues shall be done as per legal provisions / rules.

Further, the Commission observes that the necessary approval by Board of Directors of each DISCOM for implementation of scheme may be taken. All un-metered consumers opting for this scheme shall take metered supply. The arrears such waived under this scheme shall not be allowed as pass through onto consumers in future tariff or true-up exercises. Further, the Commission directs the petitioner to widely publish the said scheme & apprise the Commission about its opening and closing and the details of the amount collected along with the amount of arrears waived under this scheme within one month of the closure of this scheme i.e. 15.05.2011.

The petition is disposed off.
